Lost Lands, Log Boats and other Liquid Losses Jan Gillespie

Hampshire & Wight Trust for Maritime Archaeology.

A dive into maritime archaeological world of the forgotten Langstone Log boat, shipwrecks of the local area and lost settlements beneath the Solent

Over 4,000 shipwrecks appear on the Admiralty chart in the Solent area and many more are lost without trace, their vulnerable wooden hulls having disappeared through storms and time. In addition there are abandoned hulks, buried log boat and drowned land-scapes littering the area. Identifying, recording, researching and disseminating the enormous resource is one which HWMTA and its volunteers are well acquainted with. The talk outlines some of the work of the HWMTA.
